Week 5 Challenge: Picture 1

1. Draw a line down the middle of the page and label 1 side Picture 1 and the other side Picture 2
2. Draw a large circle in the middle
3. Draw two smaller circles on the big circle
4. Put two dots in the circles
5. Draw a sideways half moon in the circle
6. Draw two ovals, one on each side of the big circle
7. Draw three connecting lines coming out of each oval
8. Draw three connecting lines beside each oval
9. All done!



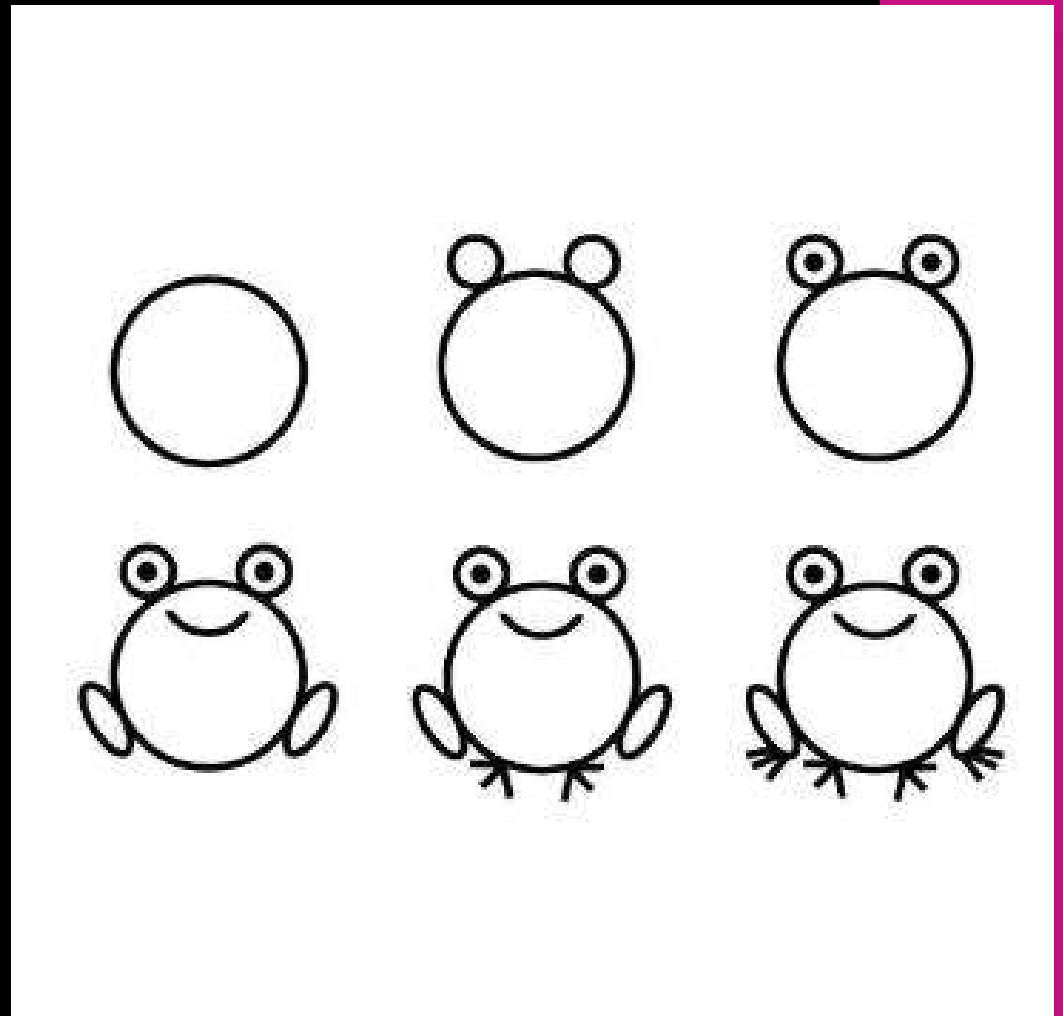
Week 5 Challenge: Picture 2

1. Draw a small stretched out triangle at the top of the page
2. Draw a small circle at the bottom of the triangle
3. Draw an oval underneath the circle
4. Draw another slightly bigger oval underneath the first oval
5. Draw another slightly bigger oval underneath the second oval
6. Draw a thin oval underneath the last one
7. Draw a line underneath the thin oval
8. Connect the thin oval to the line underneath it with two straight lines
9. Draw a zig-zag line across, going from one straight line to the other
10. Draw 5 straight lines parallel to the first two lines
11. All done!



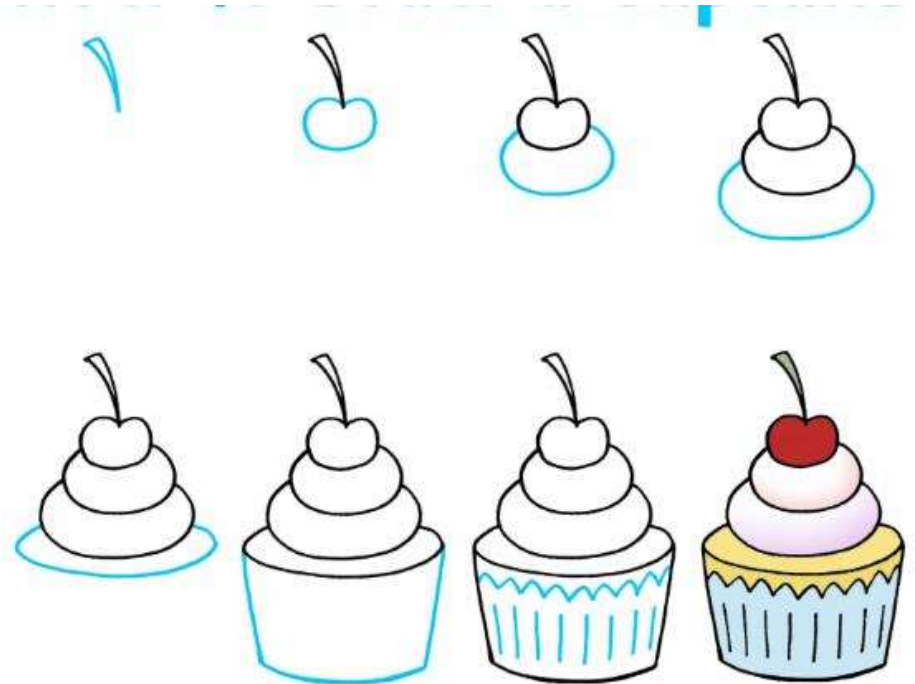
