




Israelite Family Tree

- Jacob (later named Israel) had 12 sons:




Genesis 12 - 21



God's Promises to Abraham

- God would make Abraham into a great nation (Genesis 12:2)
- God would make his name great and he would be a blessing (Genesis 12:2)
- God would bless those that bless Abraham and curse those that curse him (Genesis 12:3)
- Abraham would be blessed and would be a blessing to all the people of the world (Genesis 12:3)
- God would give Abraham a specifc land for his descendants (Genesis 12:7)

From Riches to Rags



- Joseph was leader in Egypt and he had his family (70 people in total) move to Egypt with him (Genesis 46 – 47)
- A few generations later the Israelites are enslaved (Exodus 1: 8 -14)

So what happened?

 Israelite enslavement was told of hundreds of years earlier to Abraham (Genesis 15:13)

"Know for certain that for four hundred years your descendants will be strangers in a country not their own and that they will be enslaved and mistreated there."

God's Plan for Israel

God gave us a warning about what would happen so that we would know it was a part of God's plan before it happened - John 16:33


God is protecting us even if we don't know it – Isaiah 54:17
