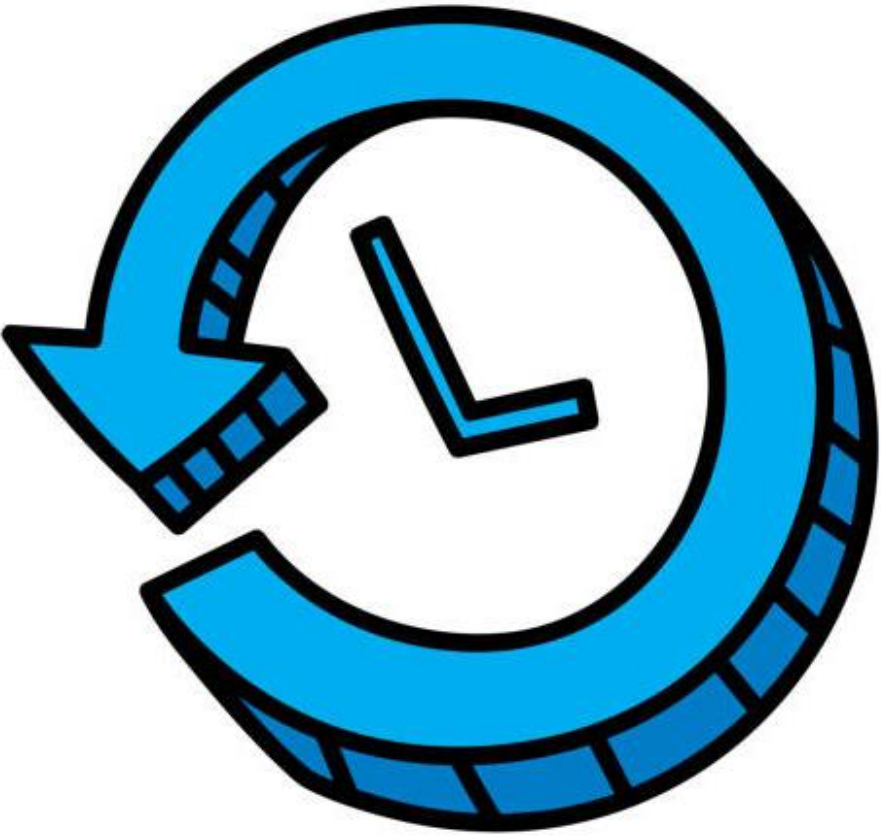

Moses reminded them about the things that had happened on their journey

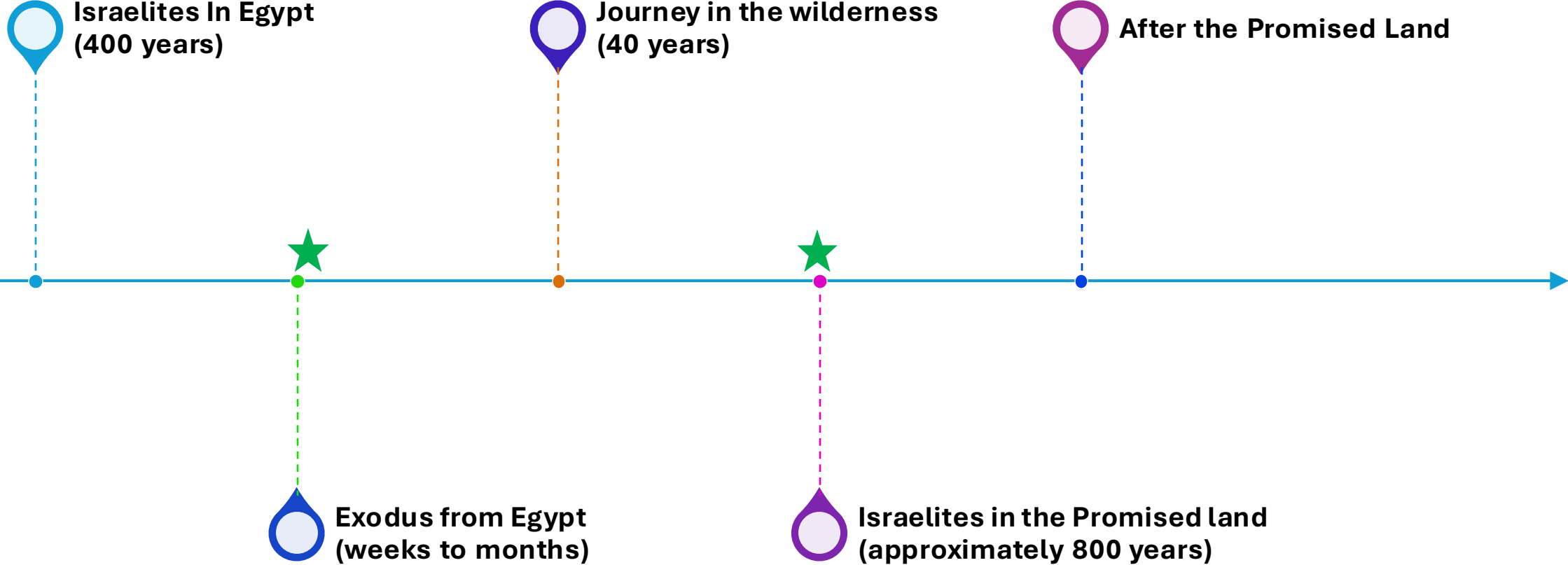
Moses reminded them about the promises and miracles God had given them

After The Wilderness

Joshua 5: 10-12

On the evening of the fourteenth day of the month, while the Israelites were camped at Gilgal on the plains of Jericho, they kept the Passover. The day after the Passover, on that very day, they ate unleavened bread and roasted grain from the produce of the land.

And the day after they had eaten from the produce of the land, the manna ceased. There was no more manna for the Israelites, so that year they began to eat the crops of the land of Canaan.

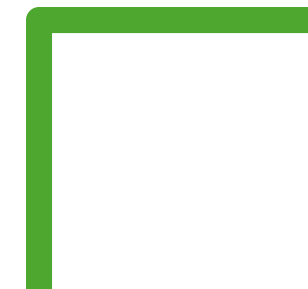

An estimate based on biblical text



26,528,200 TONNES

An estimate of the total amount of manna provided daily for 40 years to a camp of about 1 million people

2.3 litres per person



DURATION

14,600 days
